Dairy Cottage originally dates back to the 16th Century and offers well proportioned accommodation arranged over two floors with two stair cases which make us believe it was once two cottages. The reception hall leads into the sitting room with a brick inglenook open fireplace and a fitted bookcase. There is a staircase to the cellar, and another to the first floor. The kitchen/dining room provides a spacious area ideal for both everyday and formal dining. Double doors lead into the rear lobby with a staircase rising to the master bedroom, and access to the rear. The adjoining utility room includes additional base eupboards with work surfaces incorporating a sink, space for washing machine, dishwasher, fridge and freezer. The bathroom comprises a fitted bath with shower attachment, wash basin and W.C. and completes the ground floor accommodation. To the first floor generously proportioned master bedroom accessed from one staircase and two further double bedrooms accessed from the staircase in the sitting room. 








Floor Plan Area Map
